The Aquifer and Floodplain Protection Overlay District Ordinance Proposal was looked at the by Commission and all agreed that the area needs protection. All agreed that NO material extraction or earth excavation activity should be allowed

Ruth will send the addition recommendation via email to the CPC of Pam Hamel and Deb Johnson. Slim will provide Ruth with an email address for the consultant and she will send the complete document to him as well.

Ray Blake recommended that everyone visit the White Mountains Museum in Plymouth
