Slim reported that the Clean up day was a success. There were seven participants and they picked up 27 bags of trash. There are several local residents who make a habit of cleaning up their area of North Groton Road which is helpful.

Ruth reported that she called the NH Association of Conservation Commissions and was assured that we are not responsible for tracking the monitoring of any current Conservation Easements in town. We are to report to the protecting agencies anything we may find that is problematic. Ruth also learned about GRANIT a database run the UNH that lists all the Conservation Easements and the agencies responsible for protecting them.

The Annual Meeting of the NH Association of Conservation Commissions will be held on Saturday, November 2. Ruth registered herself and Slim for the meeting and Gina and Cindy will register themselves if they are free to attend.
